RE: Buried Fuel Lines

Dear Mid-State Energy Customer,

Mid-State Energy operates its gas system with a strong emphasis on safety!

With that in mind, and in order to comply with federal regulations, this letter is intended to make customers aware of certain safety recommendations regarding the underground natural gas piping to your home or business. While the vast majority of Mid-State Energy customers do not have buried piping beyond the meter, some do.

Mid-State Energy installs and maintains our underground piping in accordance with prescribed federal safety standards. However, we do NOT install or maintain underground gas piping downstream or beyond the gas meter. The installation and maintenance of this piping is the responsibility of the customer or owner of that piping. If this buried pipe is metallic, it may be subject to corrosion and/or leakage.

To ensure the continued safe and reliable operation of these gas pipes, they should be checked periodically for integrity. You may wish to contact a licensed plumber or heating contractor to assist you in locating and inspecting buried gas piping beyond the gas meter. If any unsafe condition is discovered, repairs should be made as soon as possible.

Please remember that if you should need to dig in close proximity to our gas piping and meter, you should contact The Georgia Utilities Protection Center by calling 811 to alert all utility providers in your area of your intentions to dig and allow them time to locate and mark any such buried utilities.
